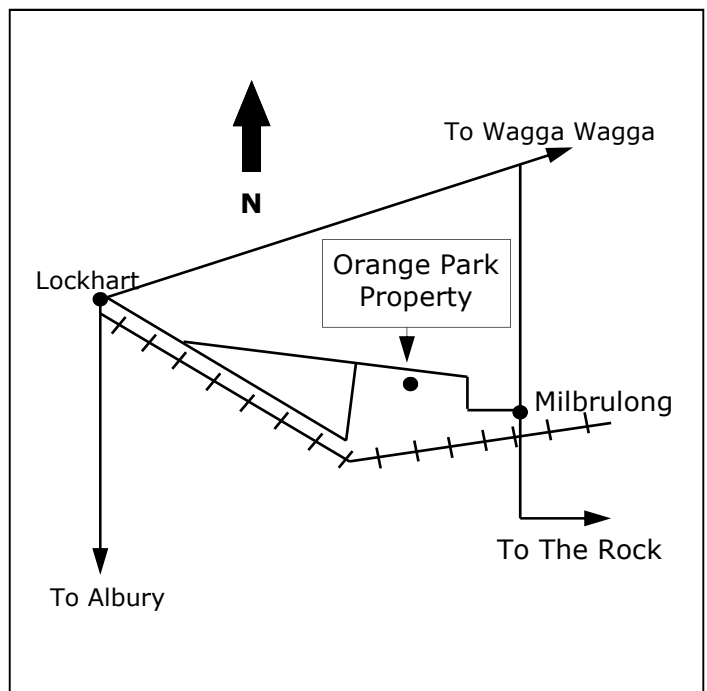

Directions to Orange Park

From Lockhart travel on the Milbrulong/The Rock road. "Orange Park" is situated 6.5km from Lockhart on the right hand side. From Milbrulong take the Lockhart Road. "Orange Park" is 4.5km from Milbrulong on the left. The property name "Orange Park" is on the property entrance.



Soil Types

There are some difficult sodic clay soils that are prone to waterlogging on flat country nearer Lockhart, but for the most part the topography is rising and the sandy clay loam soils are well drained. The nitrogen fertility of all blocks within the aggregation is high with organic carbon content typically 1.5%. Phosphorus reserves are low and soils are typically acid and require regular (every 7-8 years) applications of lime to prevent aluminium toxicity.

Cropping Programs

Continuous cropping in the area is based on rotations incorporating canola, wheat, barley and lupins. Most wheat's grown in the area are hard bread wheat's with an average yield of about 4.5 tonnes/ha. With the introduction of gypsum as a soil ameliorant, canola has become a useful crop in the area with yields averaging about 2 tonnes/ha.
